The event was held at Hampton Hill Cricket Club within Bushy Park. It was a glorious sunny evening and parents, children, friends and family ran either 2.5k or 5k in aid of our school. Afterwards the Hampton Hill Cricket Club bar was open and there was a chance to socialise with friends old and new. As well as the fun, we were able to raise £360 for the school.

This fabulous result brings our fundraising total to £13,200 so far. This is amazing news and means that we are over half way towards our target goal of £25,000. A BIG THANK YOU to everyone who has donated, attended the fun run and/or volunteers their time in any way.
