Important notices:

Gurdwara Visit

We will be visiting the Gurdwara in Hounslow as part of their RE curriculum on Sikhism. We will be travelling by bus. All children will be provided "Langar", if there are children with allergies the Gurdwara has asked those children to kindly bring their own lunch in a small rucksack which they will need to carry and be responsible for or bring their lunch in a sturdy paper bag. Please allow suitable footwear for walking and a raincoat (if the weather looks unsettled). We will be leaving school at 9.10am and returning by 1pm. There is a small charge of £2 that we ask you to contribute to which is available on Arbor under 'shop'.

> Swimming

Y4 will be swimming on Tuesday 16th April for 5 weeks. Payment can be made on Arbor under trips. Swimming hats are available on Arbor under school shop. You child will need one in order to swim as this is a requirement of the pool.

National Gallery

We will be travelling by seat belted coach which has been subsidised by the PTA (thank you!) The children will all take part in a talking painting guided tour. We will be leaving school promptly after registration so we need all the children to arrive in school on time. We should be back by 3:15 pm but this time may be flexible depending on the traffic. Any significant change to the arrival time will be posted on Arbor. Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a small bag that the children are able to carry for the day, (FSM children will have a packed lunch provided). No glass bottles or cans. We will need parent helpers to accompany us on the trip so if you would like to volunteer, please email your interest to student@hamptonhill.richmond.sch.uk.
